

Embalse de Alcántara - Grimaldo

You have to go back to the main road and from there access a gravel road going up El Cerro Garrote, from where you have a nice view of the **Embalse de Alcántara**.

The Camino continues towards Sierra del Arco, over the bridge of San Benito, until it reaches **Cañaverál** with its arcaded houses. Back onto the N-630, you go past the church of San Cristóbal and the Fuente de la República. After some ups and downs, you end up in Puerto de los Castaños, where you will be walking amidst cork oaks.

If you want, you can call it a day at **Grimaldo** or get some provisions and continue walking. If you do so, you have to take the detour towards the village.
